Pima County School Superintendent Dustin J. Williams hereby makes a public notice of the opportunity to submit *supporting or opposing arguments* that may be included in the Tucson Unified School District Information Pamphlet for the Special Election on November 7, 2017. The Information Pamphlet will be mailed to households of registered voters in the District. The District is requesting voter approval for \$180 million in School Improvement Bonds. The estimated tax rate per \$100 of net assessed valuation used for secondary tax purposes is \$0.38.

All arguments shall include: 1) an original signature; 2) the individual's printed name, mailing address, telephone number and email; and 3) be 200 words or less.
