- Examine school safety protocol and hire armed security for all schools.
- Create more opportunities for career and technical education.
- Ensure fiscal responsibility through oversight.

I and two other candidates, Dr. Bart Pemberton and William Morgan will prioritize the education of the whole child, and we will collaborate with parents to meet the needs of their children in school.
